



The F.A.V.O.R Program

Eighty three Veteran's were able to sign up for their FAVOR discount cards on October 26th at the East Fishkill Community Center.

Our Post is worked with County Legislator Marge Horton and Nelson Rivera to bring the necessary equipment for veteran's to obtain a FAVOR id card to East Fishkill. The Veteran's Administration was also on hand to register Veterans for health care.

Any honorably discharged military veteran residing in Dutchess County may get their FAVOR card by bringing his or her Military Discharge Papers or DD214 to the Veterans Services Office.

Currently there are over 50 merchants participating in this program, from attorneys to dry cleaners, restaurants, home improvement and more.




