Christopher W. DeAngelis graduated from Dumont, NJ, High School, in 1982 and he joined the US Navy in September 1982 as an Electronic Tech. After 2 years of Tech school in Great Lakes, IL, he was transferred to Norfolk, VA for a year and then to Mayport, FL on board the USS Stark. That same year his ship went for a six-month deployment to the Persian Gulf. After his return, the USS Stark was sent on a 10 week Good Will Tour throughout the ports of the USA and Canada.

On January 1, 1987, Christopher was married in Jacksonville, FL to his bride Donna.

On February 12, 1987 his ship was deployed a second time to the Persian Gulf for six months.

On May 17, 1987, an Iraqi pilot fired 2 Exocet Missiles into the USS Stark where Christopher and 36 other sailors lost their lives.
