



At 9:20AM, the same day(11/9) we join the students of Roy C. Ketcham for their Veterans Day celebration. Uniform of the day: white shirt, dark trousers, legion cap, gold scarf and braid..

On November 11th the Post will be installing flags along Route 82 in the Hopewell Hamlet at 7:00 AM.

From 8:00AM until 2:00PM, November 11 the Post will be conducting coin drops and distributing poppys at Flory's North on Route 82, near the Taconic Parkway, the Stewart's Shop at the corner of Route 82 and Lake Walton Road, and the Convenient Mart Route 82 and Route 52, Fishkill.


