#### VA awards \$418 million in grants to help Veterans and families at risk of homelessness

WASHINGTON — The Department of Veterans Affairs awarded \$418 million in grants to more than 260 non-profit organizations in June, allowing low-income Veteran families around the nation to access services under the Supportive Services for Veteran Families program. SSVF grantees are authorized to use the funds to rapidly re-house Veterans who become homeless or to prevent Veterans from becoming homeless.

The First Battle of Manassas, aka Bull Run, occurs in Northern Virginia, south of Washington D.C. It is here that Confederate General Thomas J.
